


Getting to Casa Rosa

Wherever you are coming from, aim for Fornaci di Barga (not Barga). Currently, the only road to Casa Rosa goes from here (the other one, from Barga, suffered a landslide and is closed for 6 months).

You want the road to **Filecchio**. This is what it looks like if you're coming from Lucca or Pisa. There is a huge Brico (DIY emporium) just after the turning. It takes about 15-20 minutes from here to the house, depending on your nerves and any slow traffic or incidents.





You follow the road to Filecchio, straight. There is one turn to the right, downhill - DON'T TAKE THAT! Keep left and uphill.




3 minutes from the main road there is a turning to the right (where the red car is in the picture).



The road should now look like this:



It's very narrow. Very narrow. But be brave. There are few cars, and if you encounter one, you'll somehow find space to pass each other. Just go slow. This is the narrowest bit, but you'll make it:



After this bit of Filecchio, there is a tight bend to the left, then a right, then another narrow section:



After that you still just keep following the road upwards. These pictures are just so you know you're doing ok:



After the pile of logs, you go up one last bit of road, with metal barriers on the left, and then get to the turning to the house:



Now the fun begins: Just carry on up the hill till you get to a hairpin: do this in 1st.



Then carry on till you see our neighbour's house. You go right, not left, and follow the rather narrow track till you get to our 'paved' bit. and you've arrived.
